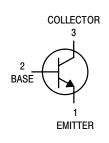

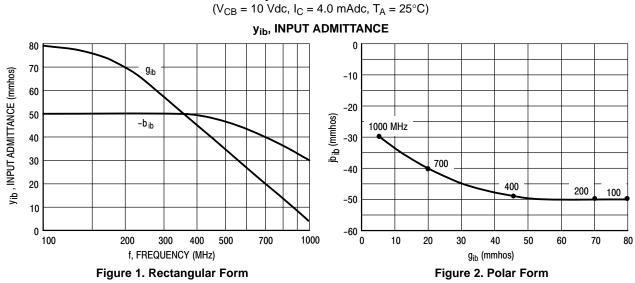

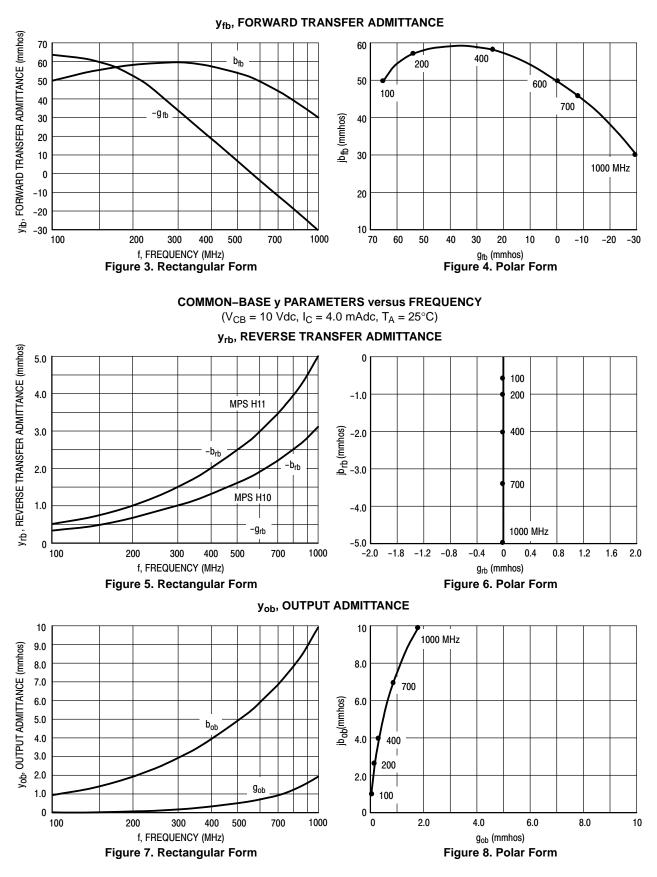


COMMON-BASE y PARAMETERS versus FREQUENCY

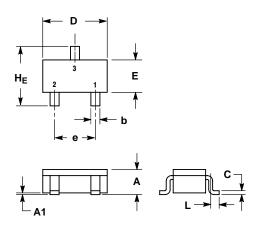

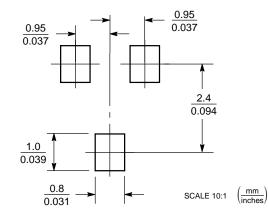
