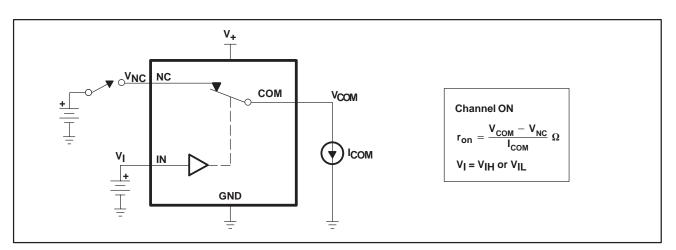


Figure 13. ON-State Resistance (ron)

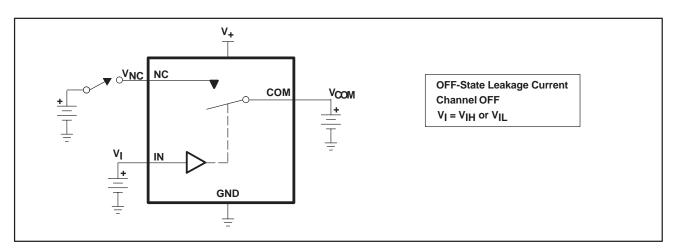
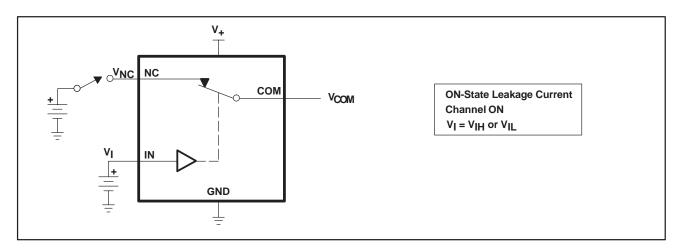


Figure 14. OFF-State Leakage Current (I<sub>COM(OFF)</sub>, I<sub>NC(OFF)</sub>)

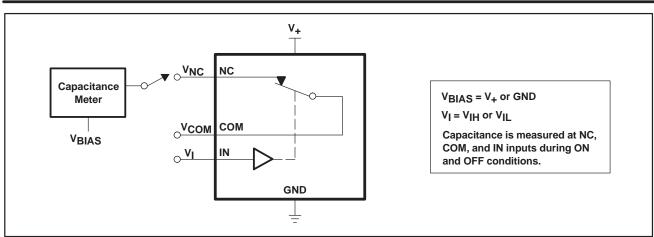
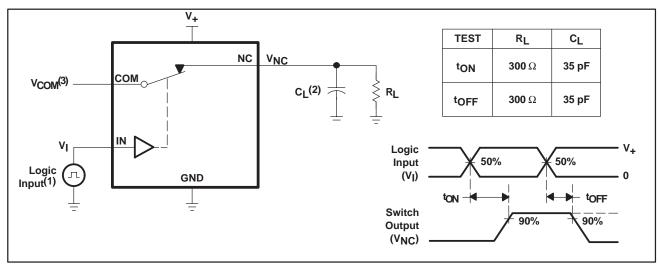


Figure 16. Capacitance (CI, CCOM(OFF), CCOM(ON), CNC(OFF), CNC(ON))

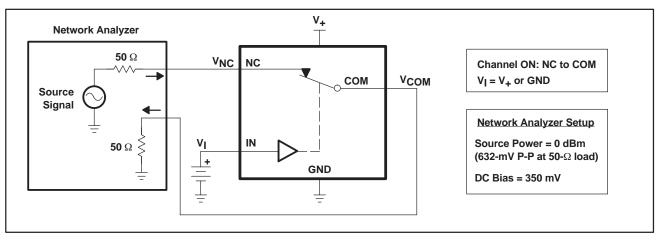

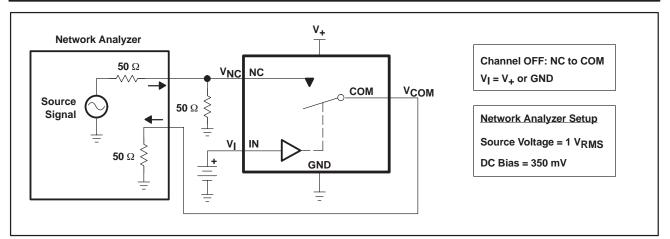
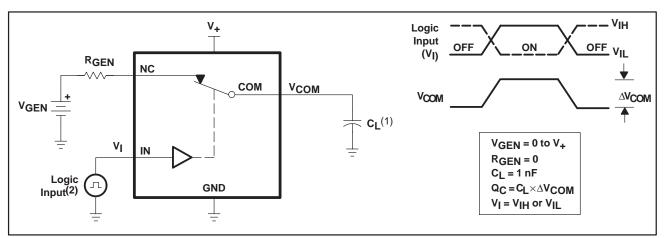


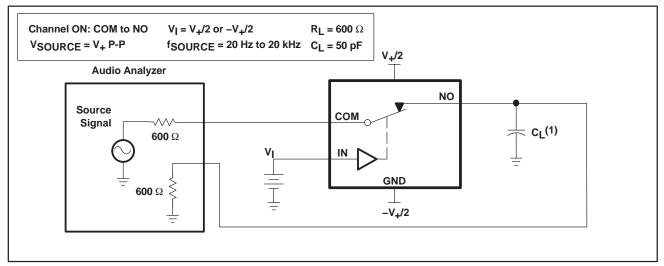
Figure 19. OFF Isolation (OISO)
